THE STORY @ HOME

Today we heard the Epic story of God calling Abram. God promised to make Abram into a great nation. Abram obeyed the Lord and became wealthy. Abram and his nephew Lot acquired too much to live on the same land so they parted ways. God told Abram that all of the land to the north, south, east, and west of where he lived would become his.

Genesis 13:16 says, "I will make your offspring like the dust of the earth, so that if anyone could count the dust, then your offspring could be counted." Do you think God means what He said? Do you think Abram will trust God to keep this promise?
