TODAY'S EPIC STORY: GOD GIVES ABRAHAM A PROMISE

GENESIS 15:1-7;
17:1-10,
15-21

THE STORY @ HOME

God's Epic story tells us of God's promise to give Abram a child. God changed Abram's name to Abraham and made a covenant with him, saying Abraham would be the father of many nations. Abraham and his wife were very old and they didn't have any children, but God promised that they would have a son.

PARENTS & KIDS QUESTIONS:

- Do God's promises always come true the way we want them to and in the time we think they should? Was this the case for Abram?
- What is a covenant? How is it different from a contract or a promise?
- What is Abraham's role in keeping the covenant with God?
- How would you feel and what would you think if God promised you were going to have a child when you were 100 years old?

TOGETHER @ HOME

A covenant can serve a family well. Write a covenant together committing to your roles as members of a family and as servants of God. Be specific about what you're committing to do and the type of person you are committing to be. Sign your covenant and hang it or place it in a prominent place.
