TODAY'S EPIC STORY: ISAIAH'S CALL ISAIAH 6:1-13

THE STORY @ HOME

In today's Epic story, Isaiah sees a vision of the Lord in His temple. The Lord is seated on a throne and the train of the Lord's robe filled the Temple. There were seraphs with six wings flying around saying, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." One of the seraphs put a coal on Isaiah's lips and said his sin was atoned for. Then, the Lord said, "Whom shall I send?" Isaiah said, "Here am I. Send me!" The Lord called Isaiah to go and give God's message to the people, even though the people would not understand.

PARENTS & KIDS QUESTIONS:

- What images stand out to you from this story? Talk about the pictures you have in your head after reading this portion of God's Word.
- Why does Isaiah say he is ruined after seeing the Lord Almighty?
- Does anything surprise you about Isaiah's response when God asks, "Whom shall I send?" What surprises you about the message God gives Isaiah to relay to the people?
- Would you be willing to say, "Here I am. Send me!" even if it was going to be a super difficult task and very few or even no people would listen to you?

Read Isaiah 6:1-13 out loud, paying special attention to verses 1-8. Use crayons or colored pencils to draw a picture of what you imagine in your mind's eye. Take turns sharing your pictures with each other.
